- 1. The completed application and cover page
- 2. A typed, two-page minimum, three-page maximum, double spaced essay titled, "WHAT A COLLEGE EDUCATION MEANS TO ME"
- 3. A copy of your high school transcript, which must include your first semester grades (First and Second Quarters) of the current school year.
- 4. A copy of your most recent SAT or ACT scores.
- 5. Financial Information:
 - a. A copy of your parents' or guardian's year 2018 tax return, including a copy of the W-2 form, OR
 - b. A completed copy of your FAFSA Form.
 - c. Must provide documentation for supplementary income (child support, alimony, Social Services, etc.)
- 6. Three (3) letters of recommendation
